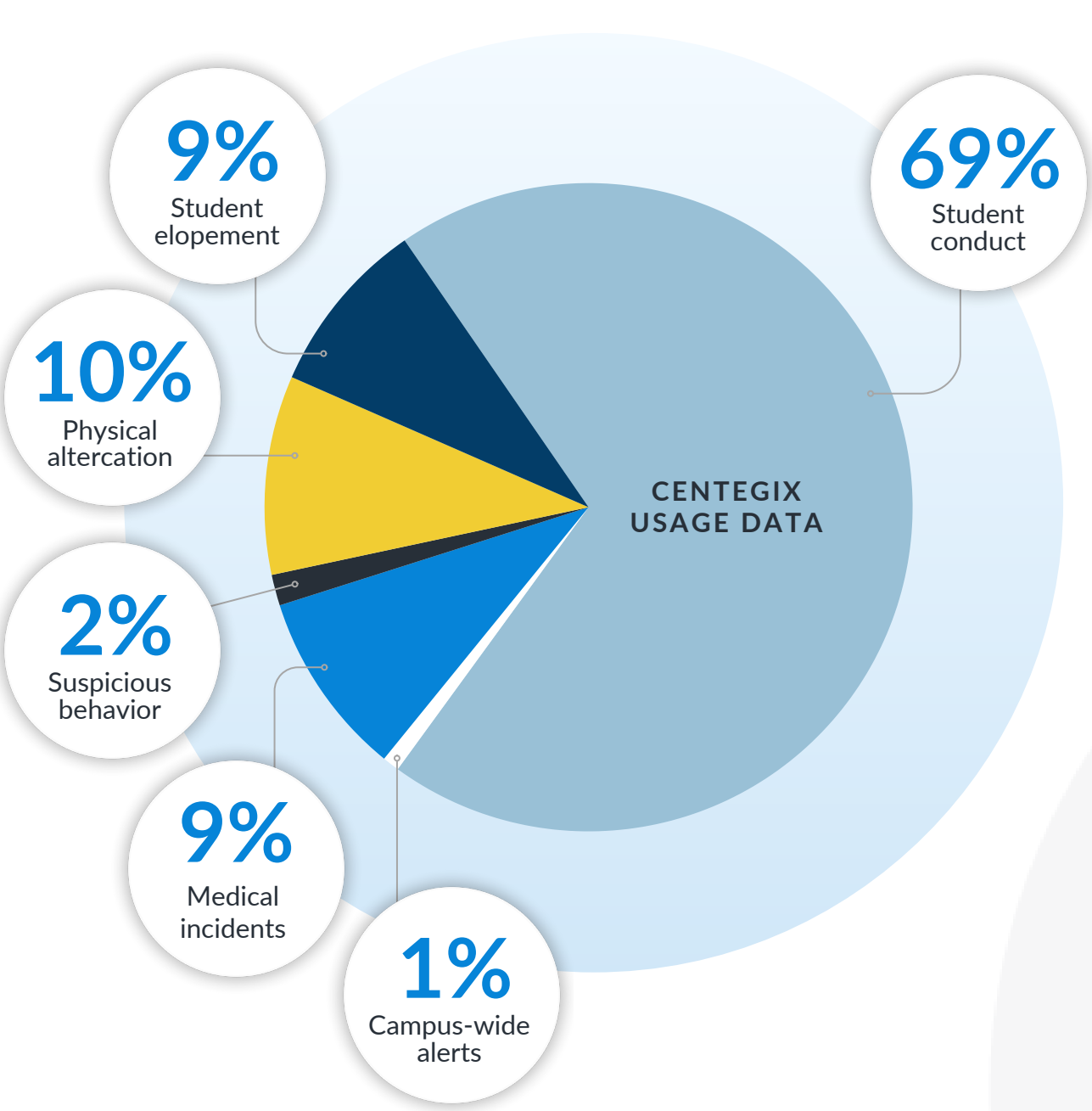

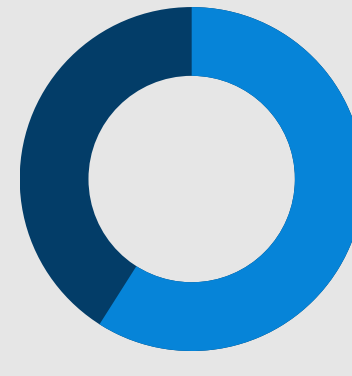

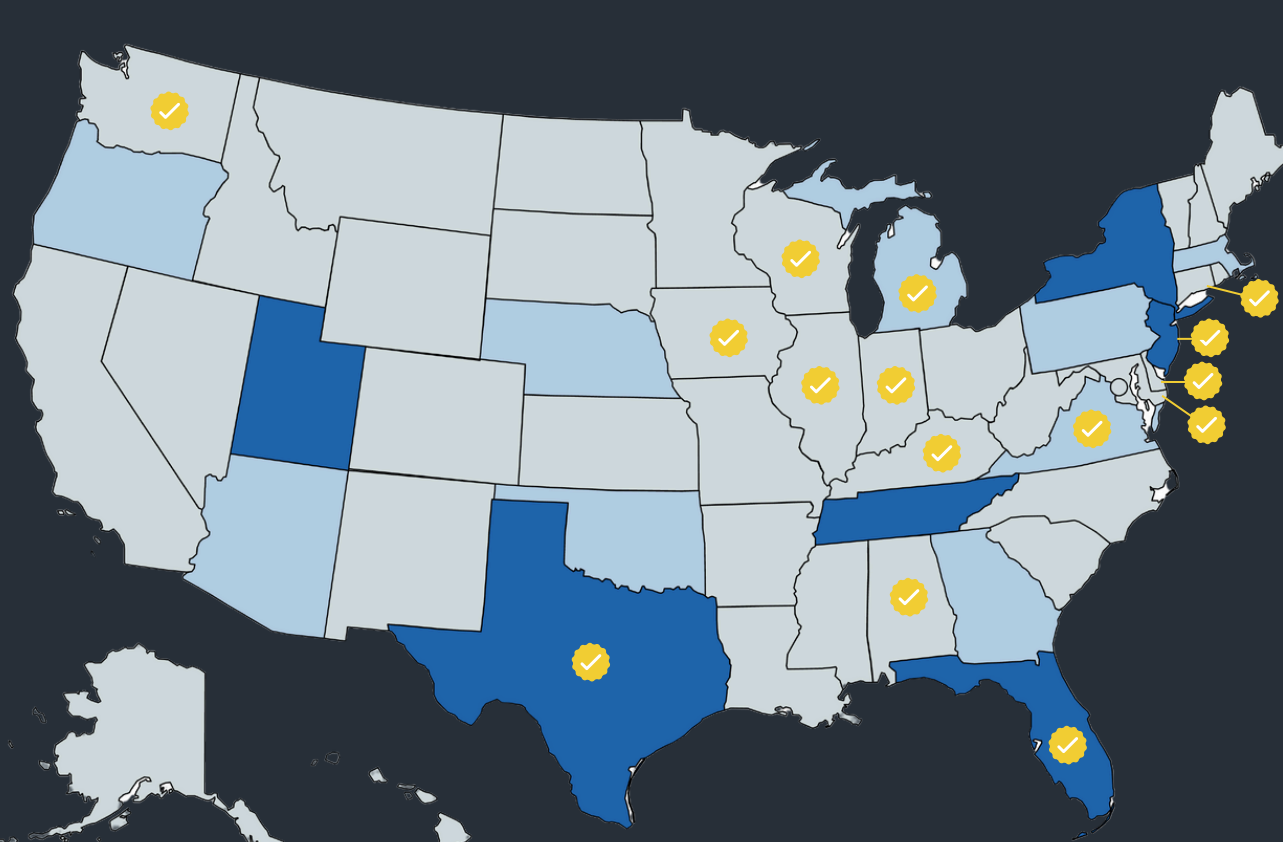
Examining Safety Incidents in K-12 Schools⁴

State Legislatures Prioritizing School Safety



Introduced or passed Alyssa's Law legislation requiring panic buttons in schools: (Passed) Florida, New Jersey, New York, Tennessee, Texas, Utah; (Considering) Arizona, Georgia, Massachusetts, Michigan, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Virginia

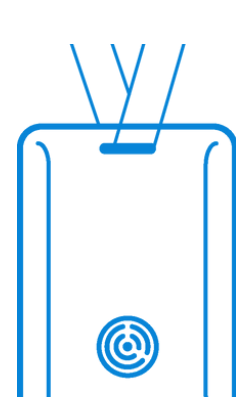

One-button, easy activation



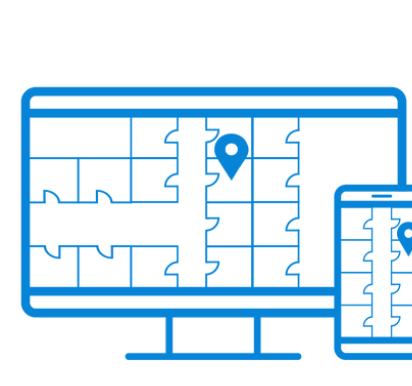
Does not rely on Wi-Fi or cellular connectivity
